The website it divided in five main categories: Searches; Family Trees; Mailing Lists; and Message Boards. There is also a Help category.

HELP

The Help area provides a good overview about how to use the site, register, subscribe to mailing lists, post to message boards, and download and upload family trees.

SEARCHES

- 1. Search for an individual.
- 2. World Connect A collection of family trees submitted from members around the world. Keep in mind that there may be errors in the trees posted.
- 3. User Contributed Databases of both United States and International records.

MAILING LISTS

- 1. Mailing List Archives Search "Advanced Search" for a name, place, or event. Read the "Search Tips" to obtain the best results.
- 2. Find a Mailing List Use the "Browse" tab to view what lists are available, and use the "Keyword" option to find a broad range of possible lists of interest.
- 3. Mailing Lists are divided among four categories: Surnames; United States; International, and Other.
- 4. Subscribe to a Mailing List in the Digest or "D" mode to limit email of posts to approximately once a day.
- 5. Post a message about your family on a surname or locality list.

MESSAGE BOARDS

- 1. The largest online genealogy community with over 161,000 Boards and 17 million posts.
- 2. Search for an individual by placing quotes around the name such as "John Jones".
- 3. Chose a Board and post a message about your family.
- 4. Explore what is available in both Localities Categories and Topics.
