


 - Ensures exact keyword or phrase will appear
- OR
 - Example "Tom, Jones" OR "Jones, Tom"
- Minus Sign
 - Example Tom Lincoln Abraham President
- Number Range
 - Example Virginia State Census 1750..1800
- Asterisk * Holds place of a character or string of characters
 - Example Lars* for Larson etc
